Fall 2010 Student Profile

- Student enrollment – all sites: 26,408 (35% or 9,224 were new to MCC)
- Average age: 26; age breakdown; < 17 (481 or 2%), 17-20 (8,957 or 34%), 21-30 (11,278 or 43%), 31-40 (3,018 or 11%), 41-50 (1,654 or 6%), >50 (1,008 or 4%), unknown (12 or 0%)
- Gender: 52% female; 47% male; 2% undeclared
- Ethnicity: 60% White; 17% Hispanic; 6% Black; 5% Asian/Pacific Islander; 4% American Indian; 8% Other/Not Specified
- Full-time students: 8,893 (34%)
- Part-time students: 17,515 (66%)
- 59% of students attended classes during the day; 22% attend during the evening; 18% attend in a non-traditional manner such as online or on the weekend
- Average class load: 9 credits
- More than 200 international students (on a student visa) from 50+ different countries
- Educational Goals: 47% plan to transfer to another college or university; 33% take courses to prepare to enter the job market; improve skills for a current job, or change jobs; 16% take classes for personal interest; and 4% indicate intent other than those listed above
