

Subsequent Success of MCC University Transfer Students* - 2007/08

- 1,815 new freshman/new transfer students successfully completed at least one course at one of Arizona's state universities in 2007-08. Of these, 36% earned a degree, certificate, or AGEC from MCC.
- Successful new freshman/new transfer students from MCC transferred 49 credit hours on average.
- The first year cumulative university GPA increases with the number of hours transferred.

- The average number of university credit hours taken by students transferring from MCC during the first year at their university was 25 and their average GPA was 3.13.
- Students who received an MCC degree, certificate, and/or AGEC before attending the university took an average of 35 credit hours during their first year at the university and earned a GPA of 3.29.
