If asked to evacuate please:

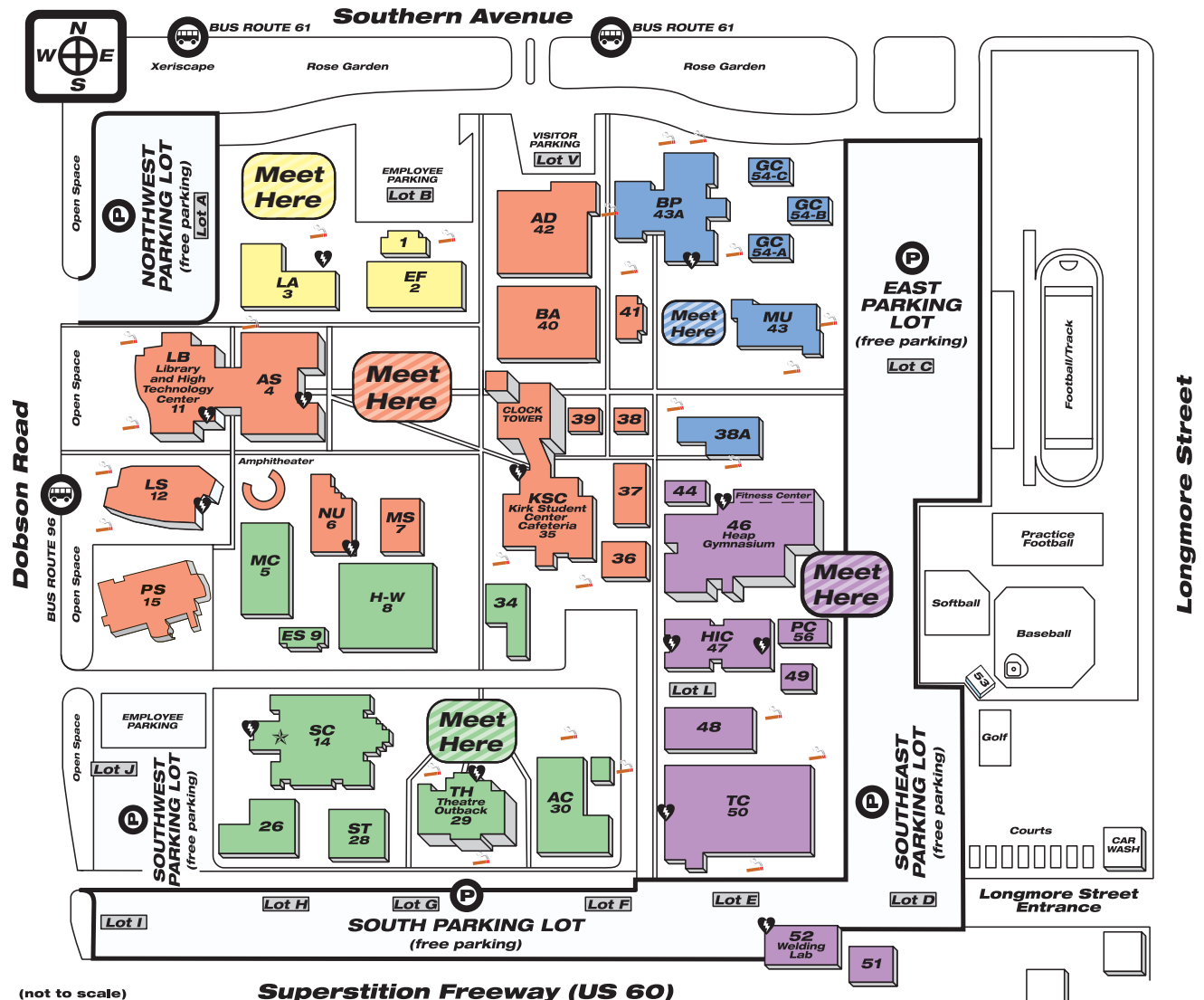
1. Exit immediately through closest designated emergency exit.
2. Go to designated assembly location for your building.
3. Check in with assembly coordinator for accountability.
4. Do not re-enter building until all clear is given by Public Safety.

AED Locations:

1. Library/LB11, 1st floor (south of information desk)
2. Academic Support/AS4 (entrance portico, to left of the doors)
3. Liberal Arts/LA3 (exterior wall, east side)
4. Business/Psychology BP43A (south facing covered entrance, on west wall by light)
5. Heap Gymnasium/46 (exterior west wall to the entrance)
6. Inside Kirk Center/KSC35 (west wall by fire extinguisher, north of sliding glass door)
7. Life Science faculty offices NU6 (south side exterior wall)
8. Health Improvement Center/HIC47 (inside south room)
9. Theater Outback/TH29 (exterior east side wall entrance next to bulletin board)
10. Public Safety Office/SC14 (west side of Social Cultural Building)
11. Athletic Trainer's Office/HIC47 (inside Trainer's Office, east end of building)
12. Technology/TC50 (west exterior entrance, adjacent to phone booth)
13. Welding Building/52 (northwest exterior wall)
14. Life Science/LS12 (east entrance, exterior wall)

Designated Smoking Areas:

Smoking on campus is permitted at designated locations only.

In addition and in accordance with A.R.S. 36-601.01, which prohibits smoking within a reasonable distance of an entrance or exit, and where reasonable distance is defined in state administrative rule as a minimum of 20 feet, the 25-foot limit established by the MCCCD helps to minimize smoke from entering a building.

MCC's smoking policy will supersede state and local doctrine when criteria is more stringent such as, smoking permitted in designated smoking areas only.

Designated smoking areas are consistent with the intent and spirit of various state and local doctrines that either limit or prohibit smoking in public areas. Maps reflecting the designated areas are being updated to reflect this change. Questions related to these locations can be directed to Occupational Health & Safety at (480) 461-7360.

Notice/Update--Enforcement Process: To ensure reasonable notice and quality customer service, violators of the smoking administrative regulation will be cited as follows: Initial violation, **notice** will be provided regarding the smoking regulation and **information** shared on smoking permitted and restricted areas; Repeat violations will warrant appropriate disciplinary action and violators will be referred to the appropriate administrative office (Dean of Students Affairs or the Vice President of Administration). The range of corrective action for campus violations can be found in the policy and procedures handbooks for students and employees.

Smoking Permitted In Designated Areas Only

Designated areas are identified by the presence of signs signifying them as:

Designated Smoking Areas.

These areas are also identifiable by the presence of large ashtrays. All ashtrays have been removed from non-smoking areas. Ashtrays may only be relocated by designated college authorities.

All MCC buildings are “smoke-free” with no smoking allowed at any time. Smoking on campus is permitted at designated locations only.

Designated smoking areas are consistent with the intent and spirit of various state and local doctrines that either limit or prohibit smoking in public areas. MCC's smoking policy may supersede state, city and district guidelines in identifying specific smoking areas.

Smoking locations are identified with signs reading, “**DESIGNATED SMOKING AREA**”.

Locations of designated smoking areas will be reflected on the campus map. Please note that when irrigation occurs some of these areas may be impacted.

To report a violation of MCC's smoking policy, contact Public Safety at 480-461-7046, and or Dean of Student Affairs at 480-461-7932.

Repeat offenders will be identified and disciplinary action will be taken accordingly via Public Safety, Student Affairs and Administration.
