

INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE SELECTION PROCESS (page 4 of 5)
FORENSIC CONFERENCE MAY 2008

- 1) Type a one page paper as you would for a college level project, telling about yourself and why you want to attend this Conference. Include a description of your current and future goals in education & career choices. You will be presenting a Power Point lecture in Fall 2008 to the MCC students; one in the day and one in the evening. This lecture will be the collaborative effort of yours, another attending student and the advisor. Explain how you would go about this task ie: Will you take a laptop and a camera with you and begin the project in the evening after the each day of conference, including photos of the presentations? Will you come home with a 'rough draft' of your Power Point?
- 2) Obtain 5 signatures and a short form reference from 5 of your fellow students that reinforces your paper, which they will read. There will be a preprinted form in your packet that you may reproduce as needed.
- 3) Go to a Program Advisor with your transcripts and produce an analysis of your curriculum that shows you will be enrolled at MCC in Fall 2008. Include your transcripts with your Selection Process required paperwork , as well as the information completed by your Program Advisor.
- 4) Include a resume, just as if you were applying for a job in the field of Forensics.
- 5) You may for Extra Credit produce a Power Point disc to illustrate your skills and accomplishments ie: You might include a 'crime scene project' that was a part of one of your classes or use this opportunity to be creative.
- 6) Obtain one signed letter from one of your current instructors that addresses your Forensic interests.
- 7) Make an appointment with Dr. Alvrus to review your required paperwork when it is completed @ 480-461-7913 or alvrus@mail.mc.maricopa.edu YOU MUST COMPLETE YOUR INTERVIEW BEFORE MARCH 28, 2008. MAKE YOUR APPOINTMENT FOR THE INTERVIEW AT LEAST ONE WEEK IN ADVANCE OF THE DEADLINE. (Hint: Dress for Success)
