

## **2009 Summer Financial Aid Information Sheet**

Here are the basics of the Summer Financial Aid process. On the other side are more of the “details”. The detailed information provided should answer most of your questions and may save a phone call or a visit to our office.

### **FEE PAYMENT**

- ❖ You can register and pay fees yourself, OR
- ❖ You can go online to the MCC WEBSITE at [www.my.maricopa.edu](http://www.my.maricopa.edu) and enroll in the Tuition Payment Plan.

OUR OFFICE WILL TRY TO PROCESS AND AWARD YOUR APPLICATION WITHIN 30 BUSINESS DAYS BUT, **THERE IS NO GUARANTEE YOU WILL BE AWARDED BY THE TUITION DUE DATE.** IT IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED THAT YOU ENROLL IN THE TUITION PAYMENT PLAN SO YOU WILL NOT BE DROPPED FROM YOUR CLASSES FOR NON-PAYMENT.

#### **AS A REMINDER: YOUR TUITION IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY.**

*You will be responsible for ensuring that your tuition is paid by the designated due date.*

**Any tuition not paid by financial aid is your responsibility.**

### **The Basic Financial Aid Process for the Student:**

1. **Register for classes.**
2. Complete the 2008-2009 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). If you’re receiving aid now, you’ve already done this.
3. Complete a Summer Financial Aid Application. (Attached)
4. Submit other documents as required by our office.
5. Receive your Award notification. Allow a couple of weeks for processing.
6. Expect your check. Always have an accurate address with the Admissions Office. Late start classes will delay check disbursements.

### **Available Financial Aid: (Depends on eligibility and availability of funds.)**

- Pell Grant
- Maricopa Grant (If funding is available)
- Federal Work Study (If funding is available)
- Stafford Loans

## 2009 Summer Financial Aid Information Sheet

### Available Financial Aid:

***Most federal aid programs are available during the summer. Here are the exceptions:***

- ❖ Pell Grant is **NOT** available if you received two semesters at full-time status during 2008-2009.
- ❖ Pell Grant is **NOT** available if you are not pursuing a degree at MCC (not continuing from Spring 2009 nor planning to attend Fall 2009).

### Stafford Loan is NOT available if:

- ❖ You are only attending MCC for the summer (not continuing from Spring 2009 nor planning to attend Fall 2009) and are not pursuing a degree at MCC.
- ❖ You have reached maximum loan eligibility during 2008-2009.
- ❖ You have reached or exceeded your aggregate loan limit.

### Enrollment:

*Different financial aid programs have different enrollment requirements during the summer. They are:*

- ❖ **Pell Grant** Minimum of 0.5 credits within one session.
- ❖ **Federal Work Study (FWS)**
- ❖ **As a Student** Minimum of 3 credits per session. However, eligibility may be extremely limited or non-existent. To maximize your summer work-study, it is advisable that your enrollment consists of a total of 6 hours between the two summer sessions or a minimum of 6 hours within one session.
- ❖ **Maricopa Grant-Summer I only** (if funding is available)
- ❖ **Stafford Loans** A total of 6 credit hours. Minimum of 3 credits per session. \*

*In addition, we'll only consider aid during the session for which you are enrolled. The 8-week evening classes are counted as part of the first session. Late start classes may delay the disbursement of any aid program, except FWS. Lastly, Consortium Agreements will NOT be accepted during the summer sessions.*

**\* Loan funds will not be disbursed until your 6<sup>th</sup> credit hour starts. You may be responsible for paying Summer I tuition if your funds do not arrive until second summer session**

### Receiving Your Money:

- ❖ Your funds are mailed to you before classes start. If changes to your enrollment occur (you drop, withdraw, or your class(es) is/are canceled), notify us immediately because we may have to adjust your award. You may also have to return the funds you already received.
- ❖ If your classes begin later (as in open entry/open exit classes), your check is not mailed until those classes begin.
- ❖ Update your address in Admissions Office to ensure that you receive your check.
