- I have confirmed information about audio enhancement and ability to control volume. Volume will be kept to a decibel level of 80-85 to avoid any disruption of teaching and learning.

FACILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Staging set-up (stage plot/map)
- Provide information if sound equipment is necessary and/or electrical needs for performance one week prior to event.
