## Honors Program

MCC's Honors Program is dedicated to helping you reach your highest potential. We offer a rigorous multidisciplinary curriculum that emphasizes active, small-group learning supported by related extracurricular activities. Courses are taught by highly qualified faculty, many of whom are nationally recognized for their expertise. The Honors Program focuses on developing valuable academic skills, such as critical thinking, research and communication.

### Eligibility

MCC's Honors Program is open to recent high school graduates, continuing and returning students who meet these academic requirements:

Recent high school graduates:

- top 15% high school ranking
- appropriate scores on all three placement tests

Continuing and returning students:

- cumulative GPA of 3.25
- 12 completed MCCC credits

### Program Requirements

Presidents' Scholars must complete at least 12 hours of credit at the 100 level, with at least one 3-hour Honors-only class each semester, and earn a minimum 3.25 GPA to maintain eligibility. Fee-award students must complete the number of credits for which they received an award and at least one 3-hour Honors class each semester in order to maintain eligibility for the fee award.

### Scholarships

#### Presidents' Scholarship

(for recent Maricopa County high school graduates)

- full-time tuition (up to 15 credit hours)
- most registration fees
- up to four consecutive semesters

#### Honors Fee Waiver

(for continuing students and returning students)

- \$81 to \$325 per semester
- based on credit hours of enrollment
