## What Should I Know COVID-19 Safety Statement

We have taken enhanced health and safety measures for you, our artists, and employees. You must follow all posted instructions on the screen while attending our Drive-In performances of Antigone.

An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, senior citizens and guests with underlying medical conditions are especially vulnerable. By attending these performances of Antigone, you freely assume all risks, harm, injury or illness related to exposure to COVID-19.

## Common Questions

### Will tickets be available on the night?

No. All tickets will be sold in advance. Drive-up tickets will not be available.

### Where is the performance?

The performance takes place at Mesa Community College in the Southeast parking lot at 1833 W. Southern Ave. Mesa AZ 85202. **Use the Longmore entrance when attending.** For a map with detailed location information please click on the link provided. <https://goo.gl/maps/VwUYLQCD4vnVX7Lv7>

### Will there be restrooms available?

Yes. The restrooms North of the Tennis Courts will be available during the event.

### What if I am late?

Late comers will **not be admitted** once the performance has started.

### Where will I park?

There are two parking sections for cars. Our event staff will direct your vehicles. All guests will remain in their cars for the duration of the event. Guests are expected to wear face coverings if they need to leave their cars for any reason such as visiting the restroom.

### How many tickets should I buy? How many people can I bring in my car?

You will need to purchase one ticket per vehicle. Your ticket allows you to bring guests. The number of passengers in your vehicle must not exceed the number of safety belts installed in your car. It is recommended that you only share a vehicle with household members you have been isolating with.

### Can I bring my children?

Yes, provided the number of guests you bring does not exceed the number of seat belts installed in your vehicle.

### What kind of vehicle can I bring?

Standard vehicles are allowed. Please note that trucks or SUVs and minivans will be directed to the side of the section you have purchased tickets for. Limos, busses, RVs, camper vans, etc will not be allowed.

### How will I hear the event?

The theatre performance will be transmitted over a local FM frequency that you can access via your car radio. If you have not operated your FM radio in a while now is a good time to make sure you can turn it on and manually change stations via the tuner. Please note that if you wish to use FM streaming apps they will have a significant delay impacting your enjoyment of the performance, so please plan accordingly. Also, note that this performance is being transmitted short range so you cannot access it at home.

### Can I leave my car lights on during the event?

No. Please turn off your car lights while watching the performance.

For newer vehicle models here is some additional information. To be able to turn off your lights and keep the radio on: Park. Put on your Parking Break. Turn off the Ignition and Turn the car back on.

### Will there be concessions sold on site?

No. Patrons are encouraged to bring their own food to enjoy while in their car. BBQs or outdoor grills will not be allowed as guests must remain in their cars for the performance from the time they arrive until the time they drive away.

### Can I ride my bike? Motorcycle? Walk?

No. Only cars or trucks are allowed at this event.

### Can I take an Uber/Lyft?

Yes, but you will need to pay for the car for the entire duration of the performance as guests must remain in their cars for the duration of the performance.

### Can I sit on my car?

No. Guests must remain in their vehicles for the duration of the performance.

### Can I sit in the back of my truck?

No. We are asking people to remain inside their vehicles to help maintain social distancing.

### Can I sit in the back of my SUV with the tailgate open?

No. We ask that you keep your tailgate closed as your open tailgate will block the views of the cars behind you.

### Is there an intermission?

No. The performance is only 90 minutes long.

### What if I need to leave during the performance?

Please be mindful of other guests. If you need to leave before the end of the performance understand that by leaving you are disrupting the performance for other guests. If you are anticipating the need to leave early please inform our event staff at the time they are directing you to your parking spot and try to be parked on the outer edge of the parking lot.

### What if it rains?

Performances will be cancelled in the event of rain. MCC TFA will do our best to accommodate you to another performance if inventory is available, otherwise we will issue a refund.

### What if I cannot make it? Will the performance be streamed?

We're sorry you will miss the drive-in experience. We will have multiple stream events available for purchase online at <https://www.mesacc.edu/arts/Zsi>.

### Can I smoke?

No. MCC is a smoke free campus. Possession or consumption of alcohol, tobacco and illegal drugs on MCCCCD campus is prohibited, even for those who have a medical marijuana card.
