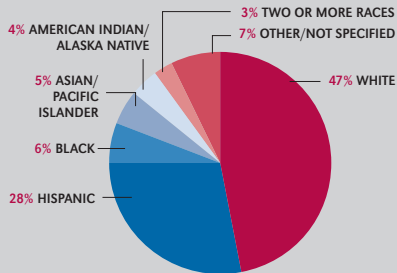

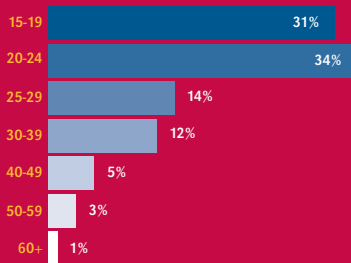

**25%** plan to enter or advance in the job market or learn job skills.

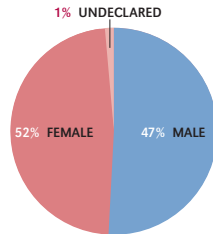
**8%** take classes for personal interest.

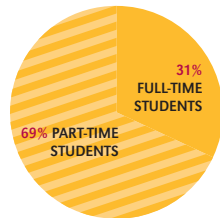
Average class load is **8** credits.

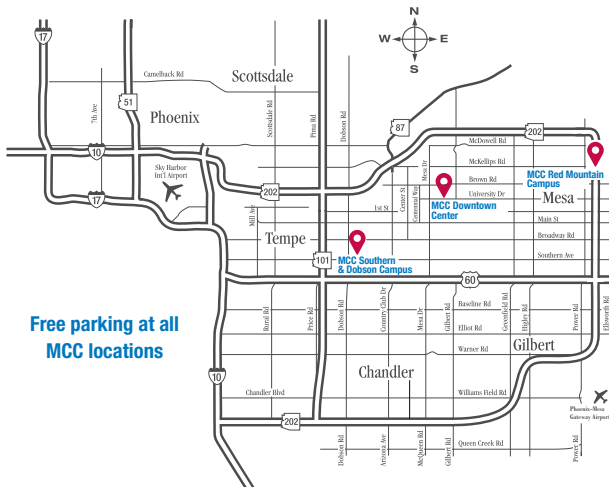
## MCCCD REVENUE BUDGET
