Applying for Financial Aid?

If no,

- EMT Basic CCL must be selected during the admissions process

If yes,

- EMT Comprehensive CCL must be selected during the admissions process.
- An additional elective will need to be taken during the same semester in order to be FA eligible. HCC145 is highly recommended (Medical Terminology for Health Care Professionals)

EMT Cohort | Reading Requirements

Students must submit **one** of the following:

- EdReady College Reading test with a score of 75 or higher.
Can only be taken online: <https://maricopa.edready.org/home>
- ACCUPLACER Next Gen placement test with a score of 249 or higher.
Can only be taken at one of the Testing Centers located at Southern & Dobson or Red Mountain Campuses
- High School transcripts documenting GPA of 3.0 or higher
Proof will be submitted during the completion of the EMT Registration Form
- Transcripts/Degree of an Associate's Degree or higher
Proof will be submitted during the completion of the EMT Registration Form
