EMT Cohort | Requirements



The following must be provided in order to be enrolled in the EMT program.

- EMT program completion requires the following courses are cohorted and taken simultaneously. (EMT101 - EMT104 - EMT104LL - EMT104AB)
- Take the EdReady (College Reading) assessment test with minimum score of **75 or higher**.
For scores lower than 75, you must have a high school GPA of 3.0+.
 - ✓ **Also accepted:** AIMS Score of 720+, PSAT Composite score of 93+, SAT score of 930+ within two years, 74 on the ACCU Placer within 5 years, or have tested “exempt.”
 - ✓ Students with an Associates Degree or higher from an accredited college are exempt from testing.

- EMT Cohort includes **EMT101, EMT104, EMT104LL & EMT104AB**. You will register for all 4 classes in your co-hort.
- Class selection is not a-la-cart, these classes are co-requisites and must be taken together in cohorted groups.
