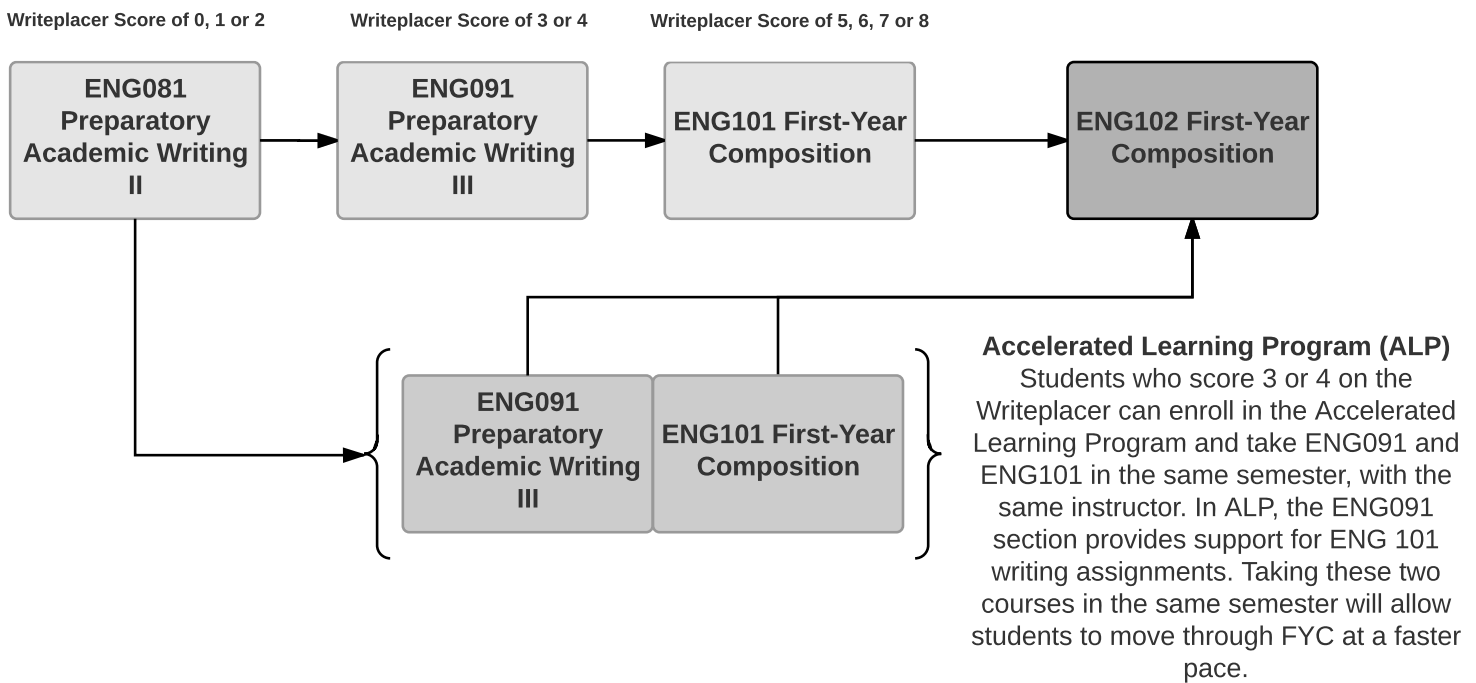


First-Year Composition (FYC)

Most degrees and certificates require that students complete First-Year Composition (ENG101 and ENG102). Students take the Writeplacer examination to determine their writing proficiency. Because placement can affect how long it takes to complete FYC, students are strongly encouraged to take advantage of test preparation resources. Students who receive a 0, 1, or 2 on Writeplacer enroll in ENG081. Students who receive a 3 or 4 on the Writeplacer may enroll in ENG091 or the Accelerated Learning Program (ALP). Students who receive a 5, 6, 7, or 8 on the Writeplacer may enroll in ENG101. Students can't place into ENG102, and can't "test out" of either ENG101 or ENG102. Students who place into ENG081 and ENG091 are strongly encouraged to review the preparation material and retake the Writeplacer test per college policy.
