# Cost of college went down for all students at Mesa Community College

In-state tuition and fees fell 1.1 percent for 2018-19 at Mesa Community College, according to recent data from the U.S. Department of Education.

Arizona residents paid \$2,070 to attend the two-year public institution this year – \$24 less than the \$2,094 charged for 2017-18.

Non-residents paid 279.4 percent more than residents this year, or \$7,854. Their price tag was reduced 0.3 percent from \$7,878 in 2017-18.

About 99 percent of the school's undergraduate population are Arizona residents. And about 1 percent are residents of other states.

Data shows 73 percent of full-time undergraduates who started school in 2015-16 received student financial aid in some form. In all, 900 students received grants or scholarships totaling \$3.8 million and 188 students took out student loans totaling more than \$638,470.
