

### 1. Who may participate in the written exam?

- a. Seniors-their scores will be counted towards placement to qualify school
- b. Juniors-their scores will be counted towards placement to qualify school

### 2. Who may attend the hands-on competition?

- a. Seniors only
- b. Two competitors and one alternate from each school

### 3. How are alternates utilized?

- a. Must be a senior
- b. During the challenge the alternate may observe but in no way participate
- c. If a competitor has a medical or family emergency an alternate can compete in their place

### 4. Written Test Scoring

- a. The highest senior and junior test score from each school will be taken and used for the school's placement
- b. Competitors must take written test in order to participate in the hand-on challenge
- c. Qualifying schools instructor will pick two students (and one alternate) to compete in the hands-on challenge

### 5. Hands-On Testing Scoring

- a. The highest to lowest team score will be used for teams ranking

### 6. Who Can Receive Scholarships?

- a. Seniors Only
- b. Must accept their scholarship with MCCCD Automotive programs before given deadline.
  - i. If the deadline is missed, the scholarship is forfeited.
- c. The scholarship monies are to be used strictly for full-time (min of 12 credit hrs.) automotive students earning an automotive degree and/or certificate for automotive courses only

### 7. What MCCCD College will accept Winning Scholarships?

- a. Mesa Community College Automotive Program in Mesa AZ
- b. Glendale Community College Automotive Program in Glendale AZ
- c. Gateway Community College Automotive Program in Phoenix AZ

### 8. Cheating

- a. Any individual caught cheating during the written exam will be disqualified
- b. Any team caught cheating during the hands-on challenge will be disqualified
- c. Only seniors are allowed to compete during the hands-on challenge, if underclassmen are discovered the school will be disqualified

### 9. Sportsmanlike Conduct

- a. It is expected that all visiting students, high school instructors, administrators and parents conduct themselves in a professional and sportsmanlike manner
- b. Anyone displaying inappropriate behavior will be asked the leave
