FOR ACADEMIC PROGRAMS:

- TOEFL minimum of 500 or 173 (computer based test)
- IELTS minimum overall Band Score of 5.5 and a minimum IELTS individual Band Score of 5.0 in each module
- STEP (Eiken) minimum of pre-first grade

FOR INTENSIVE ENGLISH PROGRAM

- TOEFL minimum of 400 or 97 (computer based test)
- Or at least 6 years of English language instruction as shown by the applicant's school transcript(s)
- 3. Official high school (and college/university, if any transcript(s), with English translation
- 4. A completed statement of financial support with a current bank statement in English and U.S. dollar equivalent.
- 5. A photocopy of ID page of your passport
