The Arizona Commission for Postsecondary Education has planned and coordinated the initiative since 1996, following the passing of Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965. The mission of College Goal FAFSA is to increase the number of first-generation, low-income, and under-represented high school seniors and adults entering postsecondary education.
