PAPER

NO PAPER TOWELS, PAPER PLATES, NAPKINS, TISSUES - those are always trash

- All types of paper, any color, any finish

- Caps and staples can be left on

Newspaper, copy paper, catalogs, books, paper bags, phone books, file folders, post-it notes, envelopes (window ok), chipboard (cereal/cracker boxes, shoe boxes, paper towel cores, etc., please flatten to save space)

Shredded paper placed into CLEAR plastic bag (leave near bin to save space in bin)

ALL CARDBOARD - Please flatten

EMPTY pizza boxes are accepted



EMPTY PLASTIC CONTAINERS

- All rigid plastic containers, #1-#7
- You don't need to wash them
- Caps, lids, straws can be left on

Water/soda bottles, ALL cups of any kind, empty CLEAR food clam-shell containers, yogurt cups, butter tubs, milk jugs, empty microwave food trays, serving platters and lids, empty cleaning product bottles, ketchup bottles, lotion and shampoo bottles, etc.

EMPTY GLASS, CARTONS, & METAL

- Caps and lids can be left on
- Wax-coated cartons are accepted

Glass food and sauce jars

Drink bottles

All milk/juice cartons, ice cream containers

Soda cans, energy drink cans, soup cans, empty aerosol cans, coffee cans, aluminum foil, food serving trays and lids

SPECIAL RECYCLING, can be recycled at MCC, but not in your blue bins: batteries, inkjets, pens/pencils/markers, electronics, disks, tapes, cell phones, toner cartridges. Leave these items in the "special item box" or near the blue bin for the Recycling Collector. We'll take your reusable office supplies too!

WASTE ONLY/TRASH BINS: food, paper towels, tissues, napkins, paper plates, gum, candy wrappers, chip/cookie bags, plastic bags and baggies, plastic wrap, bubble wrap, foam peanuts, foam food containers, plastic utensils, greasy fast food packaging.
