- ❑ **Dual Enrollment** - Earn college credits while you're still in high school! Sign up for Dual Enrollment courses.
- ❑ **Presidents' Honors Scholarship** - Tuition is paid for up to 15 credit hours for each of four consecutive semesters at MCC for recently graduated high school students with an unweighted 3.25 GPA.

- ❑ **Beca de Honor de los Presidentes** - Cubre la matrícula de hasta 15 créditos por cada uno de cuatro semestres consecutivos en MCC para estudiantes recién graduados de la preparatoria con un puntaje promedio no ponderado de 3.25.
- ❑ **Matrícula Asequible** - Aumenta tus conocimientos, no tus deudas.
