- ❑ **Dual Enrollment** - Earn college credits while you're still in high school! Sign up for Dual Enrollment courses.
- ❑ **Presidents' Honors Scholarship** - Tuition is paid for up to 15 credit hours for each of four consecutive semesters at MCC for recently graduated high school students with an unweighted 3.25 GPA.
- ❑ **Affordable Tuition** - Build your future, not your debt. MCC tuition is 75%* less than at most Arizona universities. * AZ Board of Regents-AZ University System Board-Approved 2019-20 Base Tuition & Mandatory Fee Report
