## Simple Steps to Enroll

2. Click on the Make a Payment icon and log in
3. Select Setup/Manage Payment Plan (or select the "Pay by checking/savings account" link to make a full payment using your checking/savings account information.)

**All payment plans must be set up prior to your tuition due date.**
