**\*NOTE:** Classes starting after 6/1/2021 or 7/6/2021 are late start classes. Funds for late start classes will disburse 3 days after earliest class start date. If original level of enrollment is not maintained, financial aid may be adjusted and a debt may be created. Levels of enrollment: Full-time = 12+ credits, three-quarter-time = 9-11 credits, half-time = 6-8 credits.

## Summer Financial Aid Steps:

1. Register for classes.
2. Make payment arrangements for tuition.
3. Complete the 2020-2021 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
4. Check status regularly:
  - Check To-Do List in the Student Center and Maricopa student email to see what documents are required.
  - Allow 9-14 business days for processing once all documents have been submitted.
  - Review award by clicking on "View Financial Aid" in the Finances section. Accept or decline any loans if applicable (Note: Grants are automatically accepted).

**Refund:** To set up direct deposit for a refund (if eligible), log in to Student Center and click on Manage Refunds in the Finances section.

- Refunds by direct deposit can take 3-5 business days for processing.
- Refunds by check can take 7-10 business days for processing.

## TUITION PAYMENT OPTIONS:

If not awarded summer financial aid by the **tuition due date**, make payment arrangements to prevent being dropped from classes for non-payment. Any tuition not paid by financial aid is the student's responsibility.

### Pay tuition in full:

### Pay tuition with a monthly payment plan:

## CRITERIA FOR SUMMER AID:

*All federal & financial aid programs have specific eligibility requirements for summer and may differ between programs.*

*Please note the specific requirements below for each program:*

### All Federal aid:

- Required to declare an eligible degree at MCC and enrolled in courses for that degree program.
- Have completed 2020-2021 FAFSA on file.
- Be meeting the standards for Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP).
- Consortium agreements must be submitted by posted deadline and Host school class start and end dates must be within MCC semester dates.

### Federal Pell:

- Pell eligibility is year-round and is based on any unused Pell grant funds from Fall 2020 and/or Spring 2021.
- Unused funds are determined by the FAFSA and level of enrollment for fall, spring, and summer semesters.
- **NOTE:** Students who attended full-time during the Fall 2020 & Spring 2021 semesters must register in at least 6 credits for the Summer 2021 semester.

### Direct loans/Private Loans:

- Be enrolled in a minimum of 6 credit hours.
- Direct Loans are not available if maximum loan eligibility was reached during the 2020-2021 year (unless change in grade level) and/or the lifetime aggregate loan limits have been reached or exceeded.

### Federal work study:

- Federal work study requires that a job is secured on campus before funds can be awarded. Check Career Services webpage for job postings (<https://www.mesacc.edu/career/jobs-listings/jobs-campus/work-study-jobs>).
- Federal Work Study (limited funds) is available during summer as a student or a non-student; conditions apply:
  - **Student**
    - Be enrolled in a minimum of 6 credit hours at MCC for summer. If enrolled after July 1, 2021, a 2021-2022 FAFSA must be on file at MCC.
  - **Non-Student**
    - Be enrolled in a minimum of 6 credit hours at MCC for Fall 2021.
    - Must have a 2020-2021 FAFSA **and** a 2021-2022 FAFSA on file at MCC and have unmet need for 2021-2022.
    - All required 2021-2022 documents must be received and processed prior to start of employment.
    - Earnings will be counted as a resource for 2021-2022.

### Maricopa Grant (funding is limited and restricted):

- Maricopa Grant is only available for MCC classes during the first five-week summer session
- Be enrolled in a minimum of 3 credit hours for summer session

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
