For Mesa Community College (MCC) students who have participated in a minimum of 100 hours of volunteer service activities.

Award Amount: \$500.00

Application Due Dates: Spring Semester - February 1st ~ Fall Semester - August 1st

To qualify for the MCC Community Engagement Scholarship, an applicant must:

- Be enrolled at MCC as a student for 6 credit hours or more for the semester in which the scholarship funds are awarded.
- Have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher (out of a possible 4.0).
 - Students new to MCC must show a 2.5 GPA or higher at their most recent educational institution.
- Have completed a minimum of 100 hours of service within the past 12 months of the application.
 - Volunteer service hours may only be used **once** for each semester's scholarship application.
 - A maximum of 50 of the 100 hours can be earned through volunteer service required as part of a college class or program.
 - Training, conference, and/or other indirect service hours are **not** considered volunteer service hours.
- Write a Reflection Essay (500-750 words) about the volunteer service performed, what you gained from the experience, and how you made a meaningful impact in the community.
- Have a service log or a validation letter from each service agency confirming the service performed and **must include the following information:**
