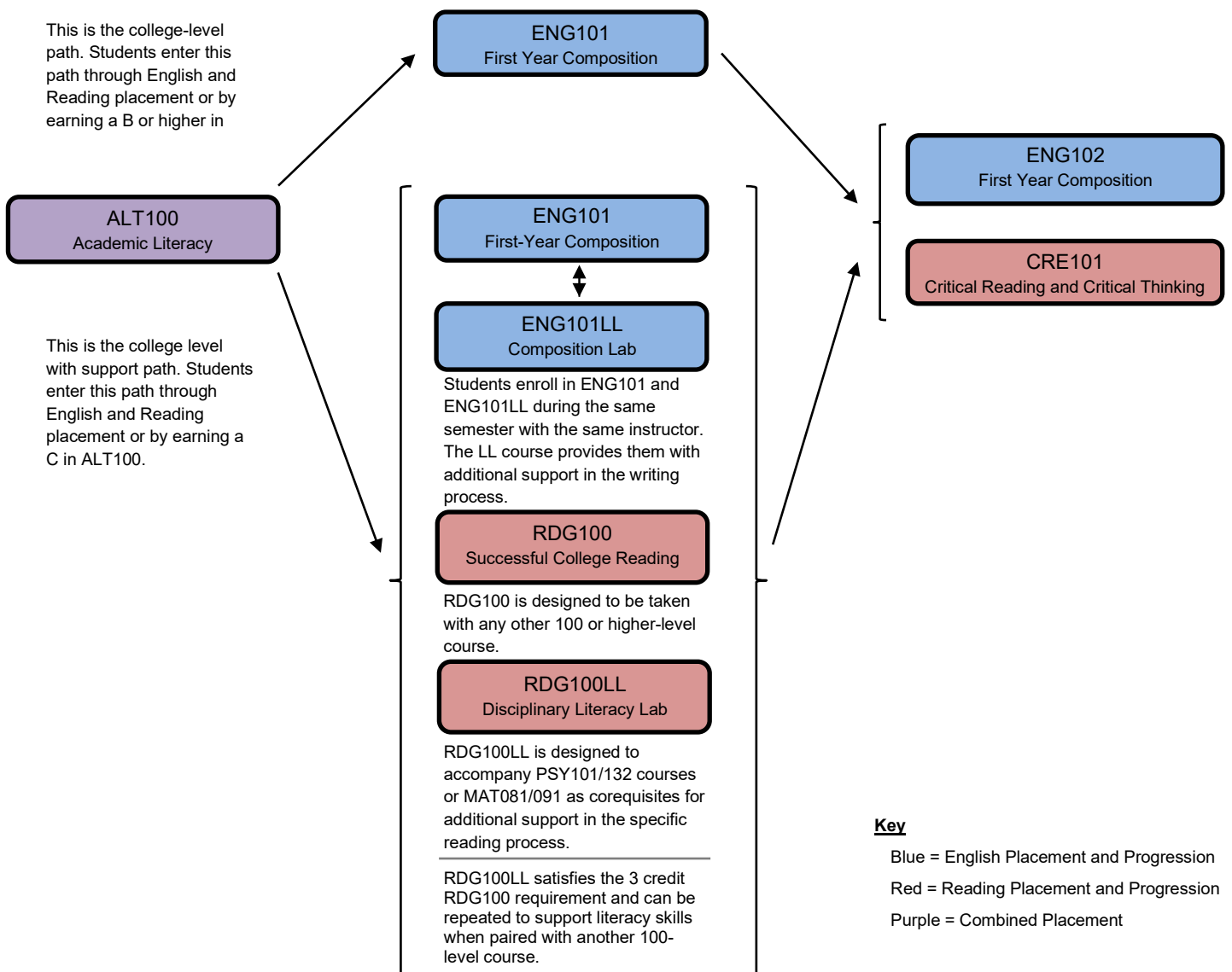




Associate's Degree English and Reading Flow Chart 2022-2023

Most degrees and certificates require students to complete First-Year Composition (ENG101 and ENG102) and College Critical Reading and Critical Thinking (CRE101). Students may be required to take additional courses to ensure their successful completion of these requirements, and to learn knowledge and skills essential for their academic and professional success. The following flowcharts reflect how students complete their courses based on their placement. Students cannot place into ENG102 and cannot test out of either ENG101 or ENG102. Students may test out of CRE101.

ENGLISH AND READING FLOWCHARTS



Placement within the English and Reading sequences will be determined by the following:

Placement Measure	Criteria
High School GPA	Attended high school within the past 10 years. Completed at least two years of high school.
ACT Scores or SAT Scores	Taken within the last five years.
GED Scores	Taken within the last five years.
ACCUPLACER and WritePlacer Scores	Taken within the last two years. COVID-19 exception – ACCUPLACER scores up to 5 years old may be used for placement.
EdReady Scores	<p>Currently EdReady scores do not expire. See Student Guide.</p>
