The First Year Experience is a year-long college program focused on providing first-year students with the services and support needed to successfully transition to Mesa Community College.


PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

Summer Start

- Orientation with parents on June 21, 2023 from 6pm to 8pm
- Summer session is June 26–August 3, 2023 (Mon.–Thurs.) from 9am to 1:30pm
- Earn up to 4 credit hours over the summer
- Maximize scholarship dollars (up to 3 terms of awards)

Fall Start

- Student Orientation will be held the week of August 7, 2023
- Math Boot Camp - July or August 2023
- Reading/Writing Boot Camp - August 2023
- Fall semester begins on August 21, 2023



Who Can Apply?

Student must be a recent graduate from a Mesa Public School. In addition, student must meet other criteria such as first-generation college student and/or placing into foundational coursework.

Benefits

First Year Experience students are placed into cohorts designed to enrich and support their learning experience (program courses include English, FYE 101, math, and a variety of electives)

- Students will receive a scholarship toward tuition and/or books for summer and/or fall FYE class(es)
- Leadership development and community engagement
- Brush up on your math, reading, and/or writing with a free boot camp over the summer
- Assistance with major and career exploration and the university transfer process
- Financial Aid navigation and individualized educational planning
- Academic enrichment, career, and social activities throughout the school year
