Placement in ESL Classes with Placement Tests

In order to better serve our students and ensure their appropriate placement in the events of online or remote instruction, Mesa Community College is accepting scores from online placement tests as additional multiple placement options. Students who intend to take ESL classes at Mesa Community College can take an English language placement test prior to or upon enrolling in the ESL Program to determine their starting point. These English language placement tests are **not admissions tests**, but indicators of students' most appropriate placement in ESL classes. The following placement tests and scores will be used as additional multiple measures for placement in ESL classes: <u>TOEFL</u>, <u>IELTS</u>, <u>Duolingo</u>, and <u>CELSA</u>.
