1) Create MEID & Admissions

Create a New Student Account, Maricopa Enterprise ID (MEID) and get admitted to Mesa Community College (MCC). This can be done at the following link:

4) Request Transcripts

- ◆ Joint Service Transcripts (JST)
(Navy, Marines, Army, Coast Guard)
- ◆ Community College of Air Force (CCAF)
- ◆ All College Transcripts (IHL)

⇒ Go to: <https://jst.doded.mil>

- Register and select “Official Transcript”
- School search phrase, “Mesa”
- Select Mesa Community College, On Line Delivery to the address 1833 W Southern Ave.

- Print 2 copies of unofficial transcripts. One copy will be turned into the school and a personal copy for you.

Must submit all transcripts.

5) Placement Testing Required

- Photo ID, MEID, Student ID# is required
- If you have attended high school within the last ten years, please bring a copy of your unofficial high school transcript
- Prepare for 2-3 hours to complete the tests
- Allow 12-24 hours for results to update on Student Center before attempting to register for classes.

8) Check your Student Center & Student Email Often

- Access class schedule, financial aid info, transcripts, etc.
- Check messages and “To-Do List” for any updates.

9) Enroll & RFB

Enroll in courses & complete the Veterans Request for Benefits Form

⇒ <https://www.mesacc.edu/veteran-services/benefits-forms>

- This form is required for EVERY semester.
- Please ensure you are being charged at IN-STATE tuition rate. VA Education Benefits **do not** cover Out-Of-State tuition.
- DO NOT delay your benefits, it is very important to select the correct program of study.

10) Check College Financial Plan

Go to your student center and click on View Financial Aid. You will see a link entitled “College Financial Plan”. This will show an estimated cost of attendance. If there is no link available and you would like this information, please email us.

11) Promissory Note

Check your maricopa student email for the Promissory Note. Please sign and submit upon receipt.

- This form is required EVERY semester.
- It will create a hold on your account so you are not dropped from classes for non payment.

12) New Student Orientation
